First Step Home is a beautiful campus, located in Walnut Hills, designed to provide treatment for substance use and mental health disorders, with a full continuum of care for all women, including specialized services for pregnant women and women with children. We offer withdrawal stabilization with MAT options (including Methadone), residential, intensive outpatient and outpatient with supportive housing, and sober living services. Wraparound services include our Maternal Addiction Program, Child Resiliency Program, Vocational Services Program, Nursing and Medical Care, the Terry Schoenling Home for Mothers and Infants, and our newest addition, the Family Unity Center, developed to provide integrated services and support for our clients and their families.
